- Papers must follow the prescribed standard academic format following an abstract with the Name of author(s), E-mail ID, Contact Number, Title of the Paper, Technical Session and College/Institution's Name. The paper should be submitted as a soft copy in MS Word format with Times New Roman (English) / Devlys 010 or Krutidev 010 (Hindi); Font Size 12 pt and Line Spacing 1.5. The submission must be sent to the Conference Organizing Secretary at subodhmahilacollegeconference@gmail.com by 10 January 2026
- All papers will be subjected to peer review by a technical committee before being accepted for presentation. Accepted papers will be categorized as High Quality Papers or Satisfactory Papers. A 10-minute presentation will be allotted to High Quality Papers, while Satisfactory Papers will be given 5 minutes for a summary presentation. Abstracts received on or before 10 January 2026 will be considered for publication in the e-conference proceedings with ISBN

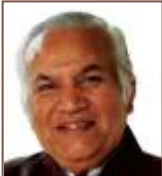

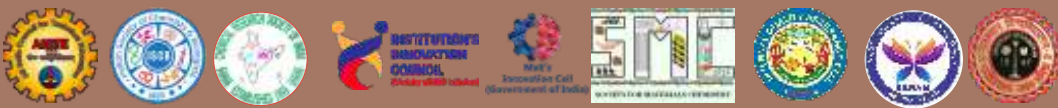
